## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What is Tralee Harriers, St. Patrick's Half Marathon 10k and 5k?

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020

Tralee Harriers Half Marathon 10k and 5k

This event is run by Tralee Harriers AC with the sole purpose of raising funds for the development of their training grounds

The event includes a Half Marathon (13.1 miles) a 10Km & a 5Km. Tralee Harriers also host a 10Km in August as part of the Rose of Tralee Festival

### How do I enter?

### What is the entry fee?

The online entry fee is

€37.50 for the Half Marathon,

€27.00 for the 10Km

€15.00 for the 5Km

### When is the event taking place?

The event takes place on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020

09:30 am for the Half Marathon

10:00 am for the 10K & 5Km

### Where do I get my race number?

Race number collection is from the Rose Hotel 4pm to 8pm Friday 13<sup>th</sup> and from 7.00am to 8.45am on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup>. It is a short walk to the start line from number collection. Bag drop is also available here

### What does my entry fee to Tralee Marathon include?

Your fee covers the following:

- Race entry
- Finishers T-shirt
- Finishers Medal
- Glass Trophies for the Top Finishers in both races
- Professional Chip Timing
- Fully stocked Refreshment Stand after the event
- Water, first aid stations and toilets are available along the route
- Entertainment at Start and Finish Lines as well as along the route

## What is the route?

We have retained our very popular routes

The 10K is a looped route from the Tralee Bay Wetlands Centre round by Blennerville and back to the Centre

The Half marathon follows the canal path, down to Tralee Bay, into town and out into the countryside and back to the canals and river walks finishing back at the start Line.

## Where is the Race Start and Finish Line?

The start and finish line is located at Tralee Bay Wetlands Centre on the south side of the town.

## Are there Pacers?

## Is the race being timed?

In association with athletics Ireland, Ronan Wogan and his team from Myrunresults.ie are doing the timing again this year

## How is the race signposted?

The 10K is a looped route and KM Placards are posted along the route

The Half Marathon has Mile Marker Placards posted along the route with additional markers on the road surface.

## Are there Water stations/First Aid?

Yes, there are Water stations roughly every 3 miles and First Aid facilities at the start/ finish line with an ambulance following the Half Marathon route

## Is there parking at the start and finish line?

There is NO parking at the start & finish lines of the course

There is NO parking outside of the Tralee Bay Wetlands Centre or in the residential area opposite

We are advising that all participants will Use the Rose Hotel, Brandon Car park, and multi story Car parks in town

## Are there prizes?

Along with your bespoke medal and T-shirt a commemorative Glass Trophy will go to the top Three Men and women across the line in both races.

Commemorative trophies will go to the Male and Female winners of the 40, 45, 50, 55, 60+ groups in the Half Marathon.
